- **3.** Conflict Analysis: Create a presentation which lasts at least 5 minutes and analyzes the conflict in the novel. Include at least 5 visual aids and your sources in the presentation. Be sure not to merely describe, identify, or summarize.
- 4. Cultural Analysis: Create a presentation which lasts at least 5 minutes and analyzes the importance on the novel in terms of offering an example of native culture. In other words, how does this novel support, encourage, challenge, or defy the national ideals and beliefs of the country in which it is set or from which the author originates. Include at least 5 visual aids and your sources in your presentation. Be sure not to merely describe, identify, or summarize.
